Please provide:	Students are to wear their swimmers under their school uniform or sport hole colours to assist with changing at the venue. Students will need to wear enclose shoes to school, they may change into slides or thongs once at the venue.			
	Please pack underwear, towel, plastic bag, goggles and swimming cap (if required). All items MUST be labelled.			
	Students will also need to pack their lunch, recess and water bottle for the day. There may be opportunities for the canteen however this will be very limited.			
	Coloured crepe paper streamers, hair colour and coloured zinc are NOT permitted.			
Additional information:	Parents who are transporting students to the early events who aren't their own child will need to provide the front office with copies of their driver's licence, car registration and insurance. Students who do not attend the swimming carnival are required to attend school, we will organise alternate activities and supervision. Parents may attend, however they are not to sit or stand on the side where students are seated. We may ask for parent volunteers to help with timing.
