Medical Disclaimer

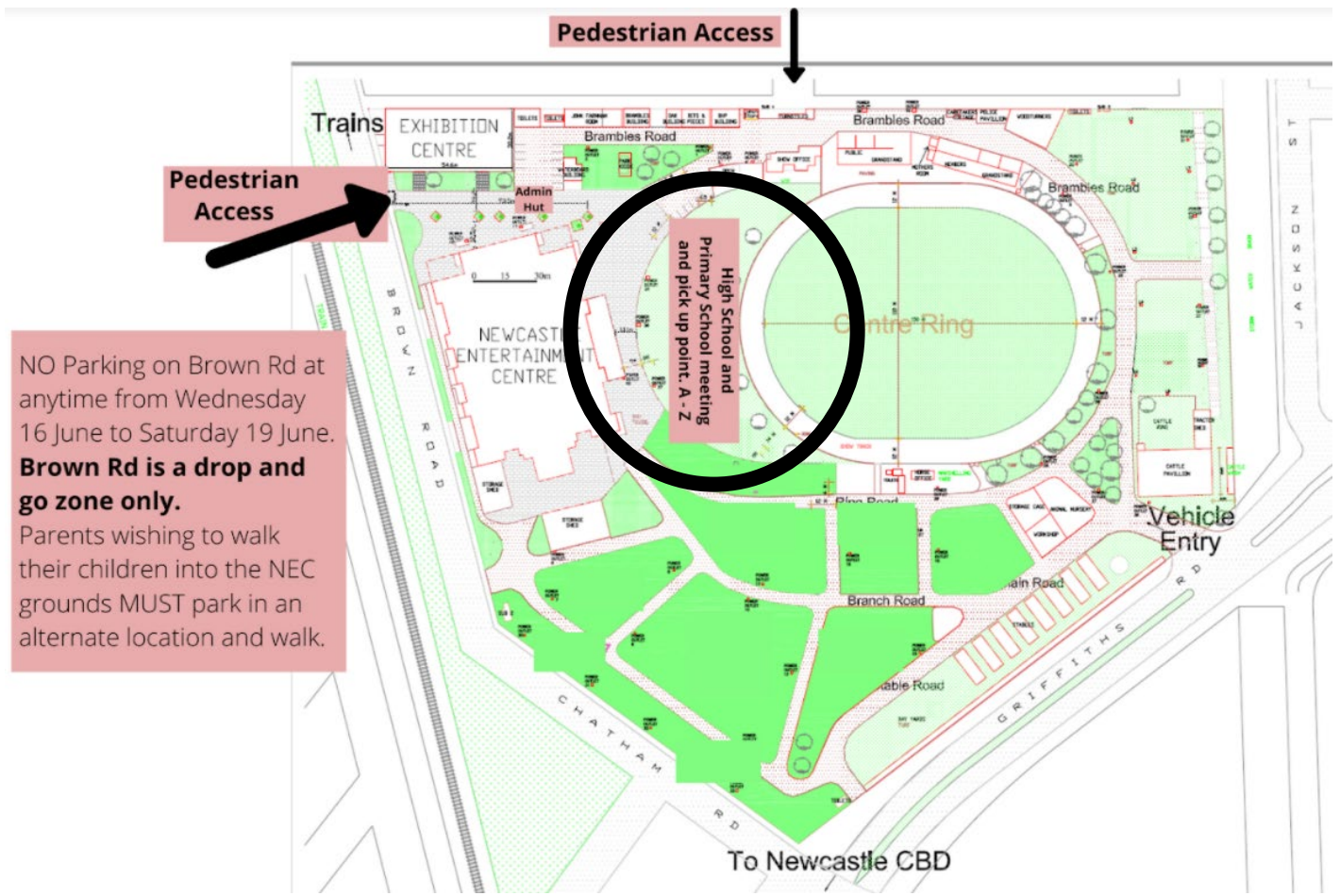

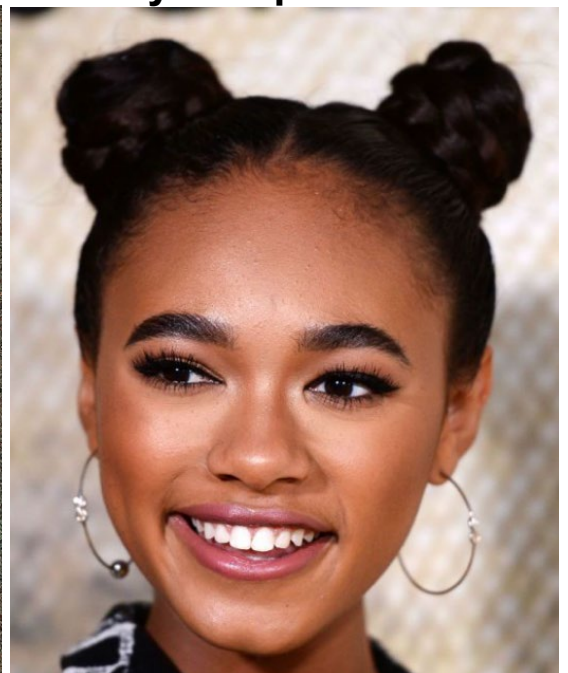
The student meeting point is circled.
