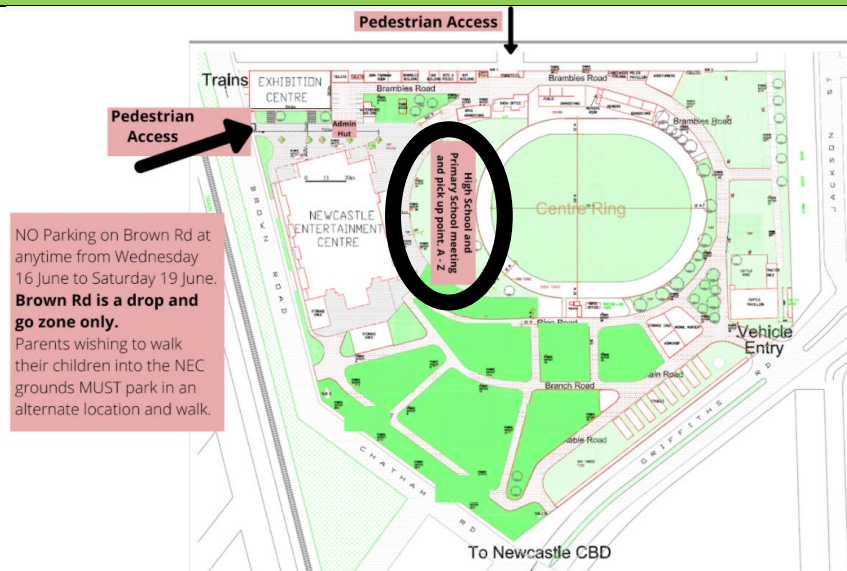
Dear Parents and Carers,

Matinee Performance:	Saturday 18 June, 2022 12:15pm Arrival time 3:30pm Approximate pickup time
Travel:	Travelling to and from the performance is the responsibility of parents and carers.
Pickup and drop off location:	Students are to be picked up from the student meeting area at the end of each show at the approximate times above. <i>Look for the green BPPS sign.</i>

Hair instructions:

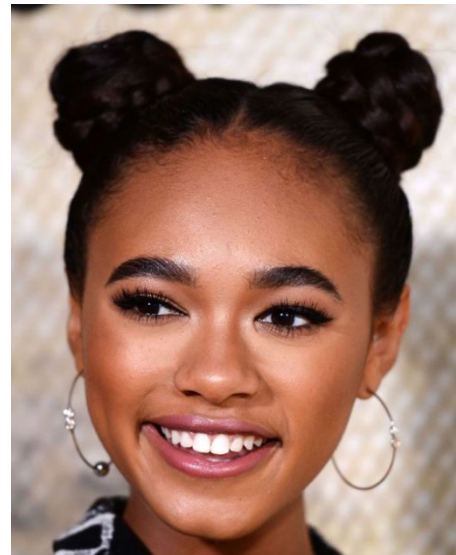
Girls:

Girls are to have their hair in **2 high space buns**.

1. Part hair in middle.
2. Comb hair into two slick high ponytails.
3. Plait / twist hair around ponytails, securing with pins as you go.
4. If hair is long or layered, you may need to place hair / bun nets over the top to keep hair neat.

Please ensure hair is held **tightly** in place. Hair elastics, bobby pins, and hair gel can be used to achieve this.

Bring spare hair elastics, bobby pins and hair gel (no hairspray).



Boys:

Option of space buns the same as the girls or styled neatly off face with hair gel.

Makeup instructions:

Girls:

1. Blend foundation over the face and down the neck.
2. Apply powder over dry foundation, to prevent makeup from sweating off.
3. Apply pink/brown blush to cheekbones.
4. Blend neutral brown eye shadow on the eyelids.
5. Apply black mascara on the eyelashes.
6. Lipstick can be applied prior to performing.

Boys:

1. Blend foundation over the face and down the neck.
2. Apply powder over dry foundation, to prevent makeup from sweating off.
3. Apply brown blush to cheekbones.
4. Apply black mascara on the eyelashes.

Bring all required makeup in a bag for touch ups.

Please leave ALL jewelry and watches at home. Remove nail polish prior to the shows.
